


**Keepsake Quilting Block Buster** from *Fons & Porter's Love of Quilting.* These blocks have been stitched in a variety of fabric selections from Keepsake Quilting<sup>M</sup> and designed for easy cutting with the Fons & Porter Half & Quarter Ruler. This special ruler enables you to cut squares, rectangles, and two types of triangles from the same width strip–great for scrap quilts or just making one block.

For each block we show you a photograph, piecing diagrams, and a cutting chart for 6", 9", and 12" blocks. The alternate value option is set together as a patch of four blocks-many times blocks set together with no sashing or as setting blocks make interesting hidden designs. Follow the Cutting Chart numbers for the finished-size block you are making. Then sew the pieces together following the piecing diagrams.

Sew Smart<sup>™</sup> If you prefer, cut half-square triangles with an Omnigrid<sup>®</sup> 96 or 96L or Easy Angle ruler in this same manner. Quarter-square triangles can be cut with an Omnigrid<sup>®</sup> 98 or 98L or Companion Angle ruler.

Half-Square Triangles Straighten left edge of fabric strip. Lay Fons & Porter Half & Quarter Ruler on straightened edge with yellow triangle up and yellow cutting guideline along bottom edge of fabric at strip width. (Cutting guideline indicates finished size of triangle leg.) Cut along right edge of ruler. Turn ruler and align yellow cutting guideline along top edge of strip. Cut indicated number of triangles.




Quarter-Square Triangles Lav Fons & Porter Half & Quarter Ruler on strip with black triangle up and black cutting guideline along bottom edge of fabric at strip width. (Cutting auideline indicates finished size of hypotenuse of triangle.) Cut along both edges of ruler. Turn ruler and align black cutting quideline along top edge of strip and left edge along previous cut. Cut indicated number of triangles.

#### Block Buster Sampler Quilt For 20 Block Buster Blocks

6" blocks (42" x 51") 9" blocks (63" x 76") 12" blocks (84" x 101") Fabric amounts and other directions for setting your choice of 6" blocks are listed below—9" and 12" fabric amounts are listed in brackets

#### **Materials**

20 Block Buster blocks (6", 9" or 12")

1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> [3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 5] yards turquoise batik for setting squares, setting triangles, outer border, and binding
1<sup>'</sup>/<sub>4</sub> [1<sup>'</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 3<sup>'</sup>/<sub>4</sub>] yard magenta batik for inner border
2<sup>'</sup>/<sub>2</sub> [4, 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>] yards backing fabric

Crib- [Twin-, Queen-] size guilt batting

#### Cutting

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Border strips are exact length needed. You may want to make them longer to allow for piecing variations.

#### From turquoise batik, cut:

- **12** 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" [9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"] setting squares.
- 4 9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" [14", 18<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"] squares. Cut squares in half diagonally in both directions to make 14 quartersquare side setting triangles (2 are extra).
- 2 5<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" [7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", 9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"] squares. Cut squares in half diagonally to make 4 half-square corner setting triangles.

- 2 3<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>" x 45" [5" x 67<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>", 6<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>" x 89<sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>"] side outer borders.
- 2 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"[5" x 63<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 84<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"] top and bottom outer borders.
- **5** [8, 10] (2<sup>1</sup>/4"-wide) strips for binding.

#### From magenta batik, cut:

- 2 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 43" [2" x 64<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 85<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"] side inner borders.
- 2 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 36<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" [2" x 54<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 72<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"] top and bottom inner borders.

#### **Quilt Assembly**

**1.** Referring to the photograph below, lay out blocks, setting squares, and setting triangles. Join into diagonal rows; join rows to complete quilt center.

2. Add side inner borders to quilt center. Add top and bottom inner borders to quilt. Repeat for outer borders. Note: A Quilt Top Assembly Diagram for Block Buster Sampler Quilt is available at www.fonsandporter.com/blockbuster

#### Finishing

**1.** Divide backing fabric into 2 [2, 3] pieces. Join pieces lengthwise.

**2.** Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. The quilt shown has a circle motif in the setting squares and feathers in the borders.

**3.** Join 2<sup>1</sup>/4"-wide turquoise strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt.
